FACULTY GRANT OPPORTUNITIES 2017/2018

Due to FY18 budget challenges, the grant programs offered to faculty by the Center for Teaching and Learning have been adjusted. The following grant opportunities are being offered to full-time faculty:

- *Institutional Improvement Grant*: Funds projects to improve the classroom environment and/or method of instruction. Determination based on scope of project and available funding. Most projects range between \$300.00 and \$1,800.00.
- *Speaker Series Grant*: Supports departments bringing in guest speakers to campus to further and enhance UCM goals and mission. Maximum award is \$1,000.00. Most awards are between \$500.00 and \$1,000.00.
- *Professional Enhancement Committee (PEC) Mini-grant*: PEC grants are offered through the Faculty Senate's Professional Enhancement Committee. Grants fund field research, resource materials, workshops, and panelists/consultants. Grants range between \$50.00 and \$1,000.00. **DEADLINE: midnight (CST) September 22, 2017.**
- *NEW: Faculty Instructional Development Grant*: This NEW grant supports faculty to attend and participate in workshops, seminars, etc. to learn new pedagogies. (This grant does not fund attendance at annual conferences.)
- *Professional Enhancement Committee (PEC) Request for Academic Leave*: Academic leaves are granted to enhance the individual (faculty or staff), thereby improving the overall educational environment of the university. The granting of academic leaves will be based on the expectation that the faculty/academic staff member will utilize the period for professional growth and development as related to the individual's UCM academic assignment and goals. Some appropriate goals for academic leaves include: to add knowledge in the academic field, to enhance teaching effectiveness, to broaden fields of competency, and/or to acquire other valuable professional experience.
DEADLINE: DECEMBER 1, 2017.



The following grant opportunities are NOT available this year:

- Instructional Research and Development Grant
- Faculty Travel Grant. Faculty seeking funding for professional travel should look at the Scholarly Activity Fund.
